




# Annual GDP in Taiwan (2007~2017(f))






# **Economic Growth Rate in Taiwan (2007~2017(f))**






### **Unemployment Rate in Taiwan (2007~2016)**






# **Engineering Equipment Output (2012~2017(f))**






# Home Sales of Fluid Power Industry in Taiwan (2007~2015)

#### **USD Million**






### **Home Sales of Pneumatic Products 2015 in Taiwan**

### Manpower Survey Results – Dec. 2016

- ◆ Employed: 11,315,000 (Total Population is about 23,000,000)
- ◆ Unemployed: 446,000 (Total Population is about 23,000,000)
- ◆ Unemployment Rate: 3.79%
- ◆ Labor Force Participation Rate: 58.80%
- \* LFP Rate = Total Number of Labor Force ÷ Total Numbers of
   Population Aged 15 Years and Over × 100%



### **Year 2017 Forecast**

- ◆ Annual GDP is expected to reach 561 billion USD in 2017 due to export increasing demand. Economic Growth Rate is forecasted to increase 1.92% at the same year.
- ◆ Due to the New Southbond Policy implemented by newly elected government, many Taiwanese companies start to increase business sales and relationship with ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) countries, which will bring stronger demands of Taiwan products in South-East Asia.
- ◆ The newly strict labor policy in Taiwan causes higher costs for production. In order to lower labor costs and increase production, more and more Taiwanese companies start to speed up the pace of automation.
